**Reduce, reuse and recycle metal, paper and plastic.**

**Reduce:** Try to use less (for example, use both sides of paper).

**Reuse:** Try to use again (for example, reuse your plastic bags.).

**Recycle:** Put in the recycling bin (for example, save your empty drink cans to put in the recycling bin).
