1. **Project Works or Assignments.** It is to be done in the

2. **Percentage of questions in the examination:** For Std. IX, - 50% questions will be taken from within the chapters and the other 50% questions will be from the back exercises.
3. **‘Analytical-type questions’** will be asked (in every exam) for the students of class IX so as to promote competency-based examinations. Analytical type of questions are to be asked: 20% in classes IX.
4. In each semester, there will be special classes and examinations for the subjects like *General Knowledge, Financial Literacy, and Safety Skills.*
